The family advisory services office is another building block within the scope of our initiative “Growing up well in the Düren district”

The Düren district has expanded its offer for families. To make it easier to find your way around the building of the Düren district government offices, the council has set up a family advisory services office (“Familienbüro”). It is wheelchair accessible and can be found on the ground floor of the building “Haus C”.

The office is staffed by a team of district government staff members who are specially trained advisers, guides and placement officers. Visitors can submit their application forms to them, obtain some initial advice or ask them who to contact about a specific matter within the building. They can also provide details of further support offers, if necessary. The family advisory services office team saves families time and effort with regard to all family-related matters the Düren local government deals with.

The family advisory services office underlines that the Düren district government is family-friendly, and is yet another important building block within the scope of our initiative **“Growing up well in the Düren district”**.
